What is the Bioceramics Network?

Bioceramics Network, launched by the European Ceramic Society (ECerS) aimed at creating a strong community in the field of ceramics and glasses for biomedical applications and at strengthening connections with medical and industrial communities

Rules for participants

- Logo dimensions and style are not predefined. However, the LOGO will have to fit the website structure as shown in the **reference websites**
- TARGET audience: Academics, Clinicians, Industrials
- Logo designs submitted to paola.palmero@polito.it and v.huart@ecers.org
- Logo can include the name of the Network (BIOCERAMICS), an abbreviation, or can be made by only images
- Designs supplied as JPG, PNG or TIFF files
- It is participants own responsibility to submit only original ideas and designs

Who is the Contest for?

Primarily (but not exclusively) for young ceramists and bioceramics, who are required to graphically design a logo for the Bioceramics Network available on its website. See the following **reference websites**:

Rules for winner

- All rights on the logo and its design will be transferred to ECerS
